



2023 EMIL GUMPERT AWARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: SEPTEMBER 30, 2022

INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

The maximum award amount has been increased to \$150,000 for the 2023 Award.

Applications should be submitted to the National Office of the American College of Trial Lawyers by the deadline date as a PDF attachment in an email to: gumpertaward@actl.com

Applicants for the Emil Gumpert Award should complete the application thoroughly, attaching additional pages as necessary to complete any given question. Applicants are invited to submit any additional helpful information, such as statement of purpose, financial data and letters of support, in PDF format. Letters of support from persons or groups outside the organization, such as a partner organization, judge, local government agency or community group, or esteemed member of the community, may also be included with the application.

A Fellow or Committee of the College may nominate a program. The nomination should take the form of a letter that explains the relationship of the nominator to the applicant and the nominator's support of the program. The nominator's letter may be included with the organization's application, and must be submitted by the deadline noticed above. A nomination is not required for an application to be considered.

The Award funds will be presented in one lump sum, but the entire grant need not be spent in the year in which it is awarded. For example, an organization may propose to use the funds to support a program over a span of two years.

The winner of the Award will be notified in March 2023. All other applicants will be notified of the decision at that time.

The winner is asked to provide a report one year after the disbursement explaining how the award money was used.
