# THE EMIL GUMPERT AWARD

The Emil Gumpert Award is the highest honor conferred by the American College of Trial Lawyers on any organization. The Award was established to recognize programs whose principal purpose is to maintain and improve the administration of justice. The Award is presented annually by the College, along with a grant of \$100,000 from the Foundation for the purpose of advancing the good work of the recipient.

**2017 WINNER:**



The Award honors the late Hon. Emil Gumpert, Chancellor and Founder of the American College of Trial Lawyers. Judge Gumpert dedicated more than 50 years to the legal profession, serving as an eminent trial lawyer, California State Bar Association president and trial judge. The Immigrant Legal Resource Center is a well-established, highly respected national nonprofit resource center specializing in improving immigration law and policy and expanding the capacity of immigration legal service providers. Following a rigorous review by the Emil

Gumpert Award Committee, the project was selected because it is replicable, sustainable and addresses a very important public need. In the case of *Padilla v. Kentucky*, 559 U.S. 356 (2010), the United States Supreme Court determined that if an immigrant criminal defendant is not properly advised of the effect of a conviction on immigration status, that conviction is unconstitutional since the defense attorney has failed to provide adequate representation.

**Despite their legal right to do so, many immigrants do not have any avenue for accessing or enforcing those rights** and remain subject to deportation for an unconstitutional criminal conviction (often obtained through a plea bargain).

The Post-Conviction Relief Project seeks to establish a means by which indigent immigrants/clients can obtain access to and the benefit of these new laws. The project will

**compile materials for education**

and use by immigrants and importantly will  
**train pro bono private attorneys**

in the steps needed to overturn and remove the criminal grounds of deportation. The project would not only develop the necessary written resources but also

**provide training sessions and technical assistance to lawyers, law firms and organizations**

interested in taking on work in this relatively new field.




## CAMPAIGN FOR THE FAIR SENTENCING OF YOUTH

The Campaign seeks to implement *Montgomery v. Louisiana* through the training of parole boards, judges, and defense attorneys, as well as legislative advocacy, public education and targeted outreach to victims of crime. The effort to implement the *Montgomery* ruling continues the work supported by the Foundation in the 2013 Emil Gumpert Award to the Miller Resentencing Project.

The Supreme Court ruled in *Miller v. Alabama* that states could not sentence juvenile defendants to life without parole, citing their lessened culpability as minors at the time of the crime. As the ruling only applied to ongoing and future cases, *Montgomery* sought successfully to apply it to final sentences nationwide.



## AWARDS & GRANTS FOR FISCAL YEARS ENDING JUNE 30, 2013 THROUGH 2017






## NET ASSETS




## INVESTMENT NET INCOME (LOSS)
